What is the CTS? What is its goal?

We are an inter-university and interfaculty cooperation platform of universities and universities of applied sciences: the Vienna University of Technology (TU Wien), the FH Campus Wien, the FH Technikum Wien and the University of Vienna.

We promote cooperation, innovation and interconnected research through, i.a. participatory approaches and critical thinking.

What makes the CTS so special?

Cooperation at eye level between universities of applied sciences and universities - unique in the Austrian educational landscape. In our cooperations we combine technical and socially relevant challenges with the participation of non-academic stakeholders.

What has the CTS already achieved so far?

- Strengthened the cooperation between universities of applied sciences and universities
- Enabled socio-technological research through Kickstarters
- Created awareness of the necessity and importance of the interdisciplinary approach to innovation and research
- First return-on-investments through successful follow-up funding


